Wrangell, AK December 2, 2009- Governor Parnell visited Wrangell today to discuss legislative priorities of the City and Borough. Mayor McConochie and Assembly members stressed the vital functions the Intertie will provide in energy independence, economic development, and job creation for our region while providing the maximum benefit of our natural hydro resources for the all people of the state.



Assemblyman Christian stressed the timeliness of the project due to the Canadian governments recent financial commitment of nearly half a billion dollars to the completion of the Northwest Transmission Line by 2012 bringing Alaska to within 70 miles of a connection to the entire North American Electrical Grid.

With only two years away from access to a huge hungry American energy market the Assembly of Wrangell is positioning the community to reap the benefits.
